This contested case came before the undersigned Hearing Officer, designated by the North Carolina Commissioner of Insurance ("Commissioner") under N.C. Gen. Stat. § 58-2-55, pursuant to a Notice of Administrative Hearing that was duly issued on June 4, 2025 and served upon the parties, the Agent Services Division of the North Carolina Department of Insurance ("ASD") and Jose Flores ("Respondent").

The parties stipulate that on or about April 5, 2024, the Kansas Department of Insurance took administrative action against Respondent, and that Respondent failed to notify the North Carolina Commissioner of Insurance ("Commissioner") of the Kansas administrative action within thirty (30) days as required by N.C. Gen. Stat. § 58-33-32(k).

And it appearing to the undersigned Hearing Officer that Respondent and Petitioner have agreed to a resolution of this contested case as set forth herein.

## IT IS THEREFORE, BY CONSENT, ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Respondent shall pay a civil monetary penalty in the amount of \$250.00 to the North Carolina Department of Insurance by a certified check or official bank check. The civil penalty shall be sent by a trackable method to the Department, and Respondent shall retain the tracking information and a photocopy or image of the certified check or official bank check for his records until such time that the Department has confirmed receipt of the monetary penalty. The check shall by delivered to the Department no later than July 18, 2025. The civil monetary penalty shall be subject to disbursement in accordance with the provisions of Article 1X. Section 7 of the North Carolina Constitution for the benefit of the public schools.
- 2. Respondent shall comply with all provisions of Chapter 58 of the North Carolina General Statutes and Title 11 of the North Carolina Administrative Code that are applicable to Respondent.
- 3. Except as to the acts or practices expressly addressed in this contested case proceeding, this Consent Order does not in any way affect the Department's disciplinary power in any future violations or examinations of Respondent or regarding any future complaints involving Respondent.
- 4. This Agreement, when finalized, will be a public record and is not confidential. The Department is free to disclose the contents of this Agreement to third parties upon request or pursuant to any law or policy providing for such disclosure.
- 5. This Consent Order, when signed by all parties, is an administrative action. If a state or federal regulator other than the N.C. Department of Insurance has issued an occupational or professional license to Respondent, that regulator may require Respondent to report this administrative action to it. The N.C. Department of Insurance cannot provide legal advice as to the specific reporting requirements of other state or federal regulators.

6. The parties to this Agreement agree that this Consent Order is an Order of the Commissioner. Respondent understands that N.C.G.S. § 58-33-46(a)(2) provides that a producer's license may be revoked for violating an Order of the Commissioner.

7. Respondent has read and understands this Consent Order and agrees to abide by the

terms and conditions stated herein.

8. This Consent Order, once executed by the parties, concludes and closes this contested
