IN THE MATTER OF THE LICENSURE OF MICHELLE L. GOMEZ (NPN # 14808842)

VOLUNTARY SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

NOW COME Michelle L. Gomez (hereinafter "Gomez") and the North Carolina Department of Insurance (hereinafter "the Department"), and hereby voluntarily and knowingly enter into the following Voluntary Settlement Agreement (hereinafter "this Agreement"):

WHEREAS, the Department has the authority and responsibility for enforcement of insurance laws of this State, and for regulating and licensing insurance agents; and

WHEREAS, Gomez holds active non-resident agent/producer licenses in the areas of Property and Casualty; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 58-33-46 (a)(2), the Commissioner of the North Carolina Department of Insurance (hereinafter "the Commissioner") may place on probation, suspend, revoke or refuse to renew any license issued under Article 33 of Chapter 58 of the North Carolina General Statutes for violating any insurance law of this or any other state; and

WHEREAS, Gomez violated N.C. Gen. Stat. § 58-33-32(I) which provides as follows:

(I) Within 30 days after the initial pretrial hearing date or similar proceeding, a producer shall report to the Commissioner any criminal prosecution of the producer. The report shall include a copy of the initial complaint filed, the order resulting from the hearing or similar proceeding, and any other information or documents filed in the proceeding necessary to describe the prosecution.

Gomez failed to report a misdemeanor assault causing bodily injury conviction within 30 days of the conviction.

WHEREAS, Gomez has admitted to the foregoing violation; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of an administrative hearing on the matters stated herein, Gomez has agreed to settle, compromise, and resolve the matters referenced in this Agreement, and the Department has agreed not to pursue additional penalties, sanctions, remedies, or restitution based on these matters against Gomez; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 58-2-70(g), the Commissioner and the Department have the express authority to negotiate a mutually acceptable agreement with any person as to the status of the person's license or certificate or as to any civil penalty or restitution.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and agreements set out herein, the Department and Gomez hereby agree to the following:

- 1. Immediately upon his signing of this document, Gomez shall pay a civil penalty of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) to the Department. The form of payment shall be in a certified check, cashier's check or money order. The check or money order for the payment of this civil penalty shall be payable to the "North Carolina Department of Insurance." Gomez shall send the civil penalty by certified mail, return receipt requested, to the Department simultaneously with the return of this Agreement, signed by Gomez. The civil penalty and the signed Agreement must be received by the Department no later than October 10, 2014. The civil penalty shall be subject to disbursement in accordance with the provisions of Article IX, Section 7 of the North Carolina Constitution for the benefit of the public schools.
- 2. Gomez shall obey all laws and regulations applicable to all licenses issued to her or her company.
- 3. Gomez enters into this Agreement freely and voluntarily and with knowledge of her right to have an administrative hearing on this matter. Gomez understands that she may consult with an attorney prior to entering into this Agreement.
- 4. This agreement does not in any way affect the Department's disciplinary power in any future follow-up examinations of Gomez, or in any cases or complaints involving Gomez.
- 5. The parties to this Agreement agree that this Agreement shall have the full force and effect of an Order of the Commissioner. Gomez understands that N.C. Gen. Stat. § 58-33-46(a)(2) provides that any license issued under Article 33 of Chapter 58 of the North Carolina General Statutes may be revoked for violating an Order of the Commissioner.
- 7. The parties have read and understand this Agreement and agree to abide by the

terms and conditions stated herein.

- 8. This Voluntary Settlement Agreement, when finalized, will be a public record and is not confidential. Any and all licenses issued by the Department to the licensee shall reflect that Regulatory Action has been taken against the licensee following the execution of this Agreement. The Department is free to disclose the contents of this agreement to third parties upon request or pursuant to any law or policy providing for such disclosure. The Department routinely provides copies of voluntary settlement agreements to all companies that have appointed the licensee.
- 9. This Agreement shall become effective when signed by Gomez and the Department.
